Office Safety Precautions in Effect During the Pandemic

My office is taking the following precautions to protect my patients and help slow the spread of the coronavirus:

- Office seating is being arranged in a manner that allows for appropriate physical distancing.
- I wear a mask and latex gloves during appointments.
- Restroom soap dispensers are maintained and everyone is encouraged to wash their hands prior to entering my office.
- Hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol is available in the waiting room.
- I schedule appointments at specific intervals to minimize the number of people in the waiting room to no more than one patient appointment at a time.
- I ask all patients to wait in their cars or outside until no earlier than 5 minutes before their appointment times.
- Pens, doorknobs and other areas that are commonly touched are thoroughly sanitized after each use with hospital grade disinfectant.
- Physical contact is not permitted.
- Tissues and trash bins are easily accessible. Trash is disposed of daily.
- Common areas are thoroughly disinfected between each appointment and again at the end of each day.
